The partnership between Alter High School and Class 101-Dayton is in its second year thanks to the financial investment of the Yeager Foundation. Led by Owners and College Planners Tony and Karen DeRosa, this is the first on-site Class 101 partnership of its kind in the United States.

In our first year, Class 101 was on Alter's campus for more than 40 days and met with 137 students.

With the Alter counselors, Class 101 also met with every senior for a Common Application workshop in August and every junior for a Naviance workshop in November. Class 101 also assisted at several Alter events for parents and families and began to offer curriculum support for the Alter Scholars program.

Class 101 complements Alter's resources to offer guidance and workshops for all students in four areas:

- College list research and understanding college programs
- Application and essay support
- Resume writing and development
- Scholarship and financial aid workshops

Informed and prepared students are at an advantage to find the right college fit. Too often, students' futures can be determined by circumstances beyond their control, but Class 101 equips students to meet every challenge. When students apply earlier, they increase their chances for acceptance and merit scholarships at many universities.

Class 101 is now at Alter two times a week for the 2024-2025 school year and will grow to more than three times a week in the 2025-2026 school year. With this increased investment, it is our goal to meet at least 250 individual students this year as we encourage all students to start college research by tenth grade, draft their resume before eleventh grade, and work ahead of college and scholarship applications in twelfth grade.

In the future, we hope to measure the impact of Class 101 by tracking things such as acceptances to colleges, majors and programs, retention rates from year one to year two, merit and competitive scholarship achievement, and student and family satisfaction.

# WELCOME CLASS OF 2028



Every class that enters Archbishop Alter High School brings with it a host of new ideas, new strengths, new skills, and new goals. The students that make up the Class of 2028 are no different. These 126 incredible students, coming from more than 21 different middle schools, and representing 26 different Dayton area zip codes, are already adding so much to our campus and our school.

## **The Class of 2028 - By the Numbers**

- ◆ Our incoming freshman class is comprised of 68 boys and 58 girls.
- ◆ Of those students, 102 are coming to Alter from an area Catholic grade school (nearly 81% of the class!)
- ◆ Maintaining our catholicity remains a priority as we expand the reach of Alter High School. Seventy-three percent of the class are Catholic, with the remaining 27% from non-Catholic backgrounds - largely Protestant.
- ◆ Many of our students (more than 21% of our freshman class) come from diverse racial and ethnic backgrounds that provide unique perspectives, varied experiences, and meaningful connections that make our students thoughtful and engaged citizens of the world.

- ◆ The Alter legacy is alive and well within our new class, with 59% of incoming students following in the footsteps of a family member that either formerly attended Alter, or currently attends.
- ◆ The number of families taking advantage of the EdChoice scholarship program continues to grow. More than 83% of our freshman class will receive an award from the state of Ohio through EdChoice for the 2024-25 school year.

Director of Admissions Jessica Pettit was fortunate to work with these students and their families this past year during the fall admissions season and throughout the spring and summer as we transitioned them to high school and welcomed them to our Alter community.

They are great examples of what Alter Knights should be, and we look forward (with no small amount of excitement) to seeing what they accomplish over the next four years. Congratulations to the Archbishop Alter High School Class of 2028! **Go Knights!**

# WINTER & SPRING SPORTS RECAP

Our winter and spring sports had remarkable success in the 2024 season. **Let's take a look back to all of their achievements!**

**BOYS BASKETBALL:** The boys' basketball team had an outstanding year as they were named **GCL Champions** and went on to win the **2024 Division II OHSAA State Championship**.

In the final four, the Knights led the entire game and shot over 60% from the floor, led by RJ Greer's 24 points. The Knights then took on Maysville High School in front of over 6,000 fans at UD Arena for the State Title. Alter came out strong in the third quarter, expanding the lead to 14 and survived an exciting fourth quarter to become champions. Four players hit double figures in points: Gavin Leen (12), Brady Conner (13), RJ Greer (17) and Joe Brand (24). The team ended the season 23-7, the third 20+ win season in four years!



**GIRLS BASKETBALL:** Girls' basketball had a successful season as they finished the year as both GCL Champions and District Champions.



## BASEBALL:

Baseball made some big strides this season as Head Coach Cory Allen was named GCL Coach of the Year and the team won their 1st round tournament game. This was the first tournament win since 2019.



**HOCKEY:** The hockey team finished their season strong as SWOHS Regular Season Champions.







**BOYS VOLLEYBALL:** The team advanced to the second round of post season tournament play this season.



**GIRLS SWIMMING:** The team was named GCL Champions, District Champions, and had 7 State Qualifiers: Nora Boillot, Emily Kyre, Annie Leibold, Ella Leibold, Sarah Morrison, Emma Tenhundfeld, and Iris Van Hoose. The girls placed 3rd overall at the State Meet and Head Coach Eric Wentzel received Coach of the Year.

**BOYS SWIMMING:** There were seven state qualifiers this season: Michael Bigby, Ben Kaufman, Henry Kaufman, Nathan Kyre, and Hank McCall.



**SOFTBALL:** Mary Yuhasz '24 finished first place in the GCL with a batting average of 0.563 and was invited to participate in the Allstar game. Grace Dungan finished the year with 104 strike outs.



**BOYS LACROSSE:** The team finished their season after winning their first-round tournament match against Johnston Monroe. Head Coach Joe Rayho was named GCL Head Coach of the Year.

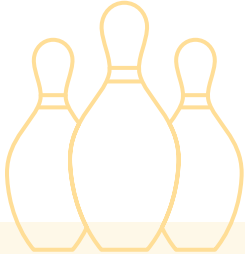
**GIRLS LACROSSE:** The team finished their final and best game of the season against Princeton High School.

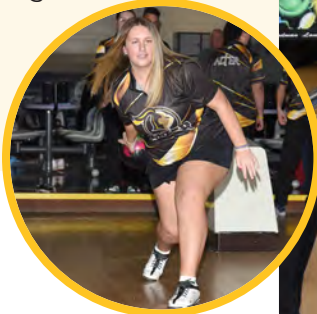


# WINTER & SPRING SPORTS RECAP

**The Castle Players** put on three incredible productions last year. The fall musical *The Spitfire Grille* was a story about a feisty parolee who follows her dreams, based on a page from an old travel book to a small town in Wisconsin and finds a place for herself working at the Spitfire Grille.

The winter play, *The Audition*, was about a new theater teacher bringing a production of *A Chorus Line* to the high school. Though the hopefuls ranged from shy to outrageous, and from diva-like to determined, everyone had a chance to step into the spotlight. It was a hilarious and heartbreaking look at the madness of auditioning and the actors who brave the process for that perfect part.

Broadway's *Beauty and the Beast* rounded out the school year's theater productions and played to sold out crowds two weekends in a row.

Spring and summer of 2024 brings a shift of focus to the **Alter Music** department. From exuberant marching to traditional concerts, the Alter Music Association has it covered. **The Jazz Ensemble** spring concert featured traditional American Songbook jazz tunes such as "Tuxedo Junction" and ballads including "My Funny Valentine" and moving solos from talented students.

## Linda Dintaman Retirement

**Linda Dintaman** retired at the end of the 2023-24 school year after 40 years as a faculty member.

An Alter Class of 1975 graduate, Dintaman began her teaching career at Alter in 1984. During her tenure, she was a beloved faculty member who not only led the Theology department but shepherded many student clubs and organizations.

Ms. Dintaman was the recipient of the prestigious Spirit of Sister Dorothy Stang Award, bestowed by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati to those who actively minister to others about social justice issues through diverse cultures. She was also the inaugural Lumen Fidei (Light of Faith) Award recipient, presented by the University of Dayton, which recognizes an outstanding Catholic school teacher in the state of Ohio each year.

As Dintaman was preparing to shift into retirement, she said, "I am most looking forward to Sunday being a day to totally set aside for God. And to expanding my volunteer role as a chaplain at Children's Hospital."

When asked what thoughts or counsel she might give to others after her long academic career, she remarked, "I invite you to align your goals with God's will and be willing to take a path that you wouldn't have chosen for yourself... then be ready to step out of your comfort zone and start accomplishing things you never thought possible!"

Dintaman is a graduate of the University of Dayton and earned her master's degree at Mount Saint Joseph College.



## Theresa Ott Retirement

Theresa Ott began her career at Alter as an English and speech teacher in 1997. She later joined the tutoring department which evolved into the Learning Center, working as a tutor and then Intervention Specialist for the next 22 years.

Theresa said, "I have always loved to read and enjoyed writing, realizing how valuable those skills were to success, I was drawn to teach them. I believed that being a teacher would be a very rewarding job that would keep me young, and [I] wanted to work with older students."

After teaching in the classroom for a few years, she realized she enjoyed working one on one with students and decided to pursue a degree in School Counseling. Expanding Alter's tutoring program into what is now the Learning Center was what she believed to be a "big God moment" for her.

Theresa will continue to stay busy in retirement by spending more time with family, especially her two grandsons. She said she was looking forward to traveling during times of the year where she's normally had to work and to having the freedom to enjoy her hobbies like gardening, camping, and spending time with friends. She said, "I still love to read and [will] always have a novel going."

Mary Lynn Miller Dorow '78

## SHOWING A HEARTFELT & POWERFUL INTENSITY

**MARY LYNN DOROW** was fiercely passionate about her family, her work, and developing the young women she mentored through the Alter Lancerette program. The power of her passion, dedication, and commitment prevails through the thousands of people she touched during her lifetime.

Mary Lynn was a woman who made a difference, who invested in people, and who lived up to her own high standards. While Mary Lynn's death was of cancer, her diagnosis never defined her or overshadowed her skills as an inspirational leader and motivator. And she never ceased sharing her love with family, colleagues, and students.

The Miller family was a tight unit of five with parents Fred and Marlene at the helm raising children Mary Lynn and younger twin brothers Mike and Mark. As Mike described them, "we were so agreeable, we might have been dysfunction(al)."

Growing up, their home was full of laughter and sprinkled with typical sibling squabbles. They created their own fun and traditions including the annual clandestine rendezvous to Mary Lynn's bedroom on Christmas Eve as they awaited Santa's arrival, deliberating on possible gifts and sneaking a peek in the wee hours at the Christmas awaiting them. In junior high, the siblings had a wild idea to form a band with Mary Lynn as vocalist and Mike, Mark and neighbor Kenny playing instrumentals. They disbanded after the third rehearsal.

Mary Lynn, herself a Lancerette, coached the "Lancies" from 1985-1987 before she and husband Ted Dorow moved from the area. Upon their return to Dayton with her eldest son Andy '05 enrolled at Alter, Mary Lynn would be relentlessly pursued by Sister Katie Hoelscher to coach again. By the time Matt '08 was a



junior, Mary Lynn jumped in with both feet coaching a small group of "non-dancers" to a standing ovation at their first performance. Ted shared, "That performance was one of Mary Lynn's proudest moments."

Her vision included mandating a single weekly practice on Sundays so that girls could also participate in sports, cheer, or theater.

She also involved male students by creating the annual "Mancie" performance. Soon enough, the Lancerettes could stretch the length of a football field during the kick-line!

Former Lancerette captain, Sophie Leen '19, expressed the expectations "Mrs. D" had for the girls, "Carry yourself with poise, always work hard, and treat others with kindness." Sophie thought

being a Lancia "would be easy, after all, I was a dancer," but admits she far underestimated the difficulty of meeting Mary Lynn's standards. As she quickly learned, it was not about dancing, it was about sisterhood, and synchronizing 80 girls into one routine could only be accomplished through self-discipline, trust, and respect. As Ted

described her, "Mary Lynn always saw possibilities in people. She once had a freshman that did not [initially] show talent, but Mary Lynn saw something in this girl and made her a manager for the football season. By the time the girl was a senior, she was co-captain! Mary Lynn could inspire and motivate anyone to reach their maximum potential, and she did it every day."

Cynthia Duckro Jecker '94, current Alter faculty and Lancerette Coach, first met Mary Lynn when she was 17 and a dance camp counselor for the Fred J. Miller

Summer Clinics. Mary Lynn became far more than Cynthia's employer; she became a mentor and mother figure to Cynthia. Later in life, Mary Lynn would seek Cynthia out as her successor. For Cynthia, there was no greater compliment than Mary Lynn's endorsement to take over the Lancerette program.

In 2015, Mary Lynn received a medical diagnosis of stage-3 ovarian cancer. Mary Lynn's approach to her diagnosis was that it was an obstacle, not an ending. She continued dedicating herself to family and her work. Along her journey, she would also inspire others. Her family chuckles when they share the story of the nurse who arrived at Mary Lynn's home to administer a treatment. As was typical for Mary Lynn, she swung open the door, greeting the nurse with a grand smile,

hair coiffed, perfectly applied make-up, and sporting a stunning outfit. The nurse, in awe, had never witnessed a chemo patient exude such vigor for life... or style!

Mary Lynn's positive attitude and "never give-up" mental focus was a profound source for her ability to rebound after seven recurrences. "My friends had no idea how sick she was because she never let people see her that way," shared son TJ '11. Mary Lynn's battle cry was "The Fight Song" by Rachel Patton. It was the song she and Matt '08 danced to at his wedding, when at one point in the evening, she flung off her wig with a bold and defiant tug.

Mary Lynn was recognized publicly for her tenacity to deal positively with her diagnosis. She received the Champion of Hope Person of Inspiration award presented by the Miami Valley Foundation and Premier Hospital.

As we reflect on Mary Lynn's life, may we all feel blessed for her contributions that made our world a better place. Andy shared his mom's mantra, "Complain less, smile more, and attack every day with a positive attitude."

***God bless you, Mary Lynn. May you dance with our Savior in eternal peace.***



## AIR EXPLORER POST 741: LAUNCH OF A LIFETIME PASSION

**Matt Desh '76, circa 1975:**

At the age of 10, Matt Desh was introduced to the world of aviation, launching his lifelong passion to fly... airplanes, helicopters, seaplanes, and anything in the sky. He attributes his love of flying to an exploration flight he experienced through the Dayton YMCA summer program for kids and an incredibly inspiring person from his youth. Before he could even drive a car, Matt was a member of the Air Explorer Post 741 stationed out of the Montgomery County Airport (now named Dayton-Wright Brothers Airport). Thanks to Doris Scott, pilot and philanthropist, Matt and his cohorts were able to take flying lessons for around \$10 an hour - an extraordinarily affordable rate...even for the early 1970's! Mrs. Scott convinced local instructors to donate their time for lessons and purchased a small plane for Post 741 members to fly. Her desire to expose area youth to aviation made it possible for Matt to earn his pilot's license during his senior year of high school!

Today, Matt owns two aircraft, a single engine turboprop (TBM910) and a turbine helicopter (Eurocopter EC120B), with thousands of hours logged in flight. He recently participated in a Washington, DC Flyover, piloting his helicopter with 54 other aircraft — the first flyover of its kind since before the pandemic.

Matt credits Doris Scott, Alter friend Matt Meintel '76, a professional pilot, and other aviation fanatics who gave him car rides to lessons and offered constant inspiration to actively pursue his passion. "Alfa, bravo, Charlie, touch down, over, and out. Roger."

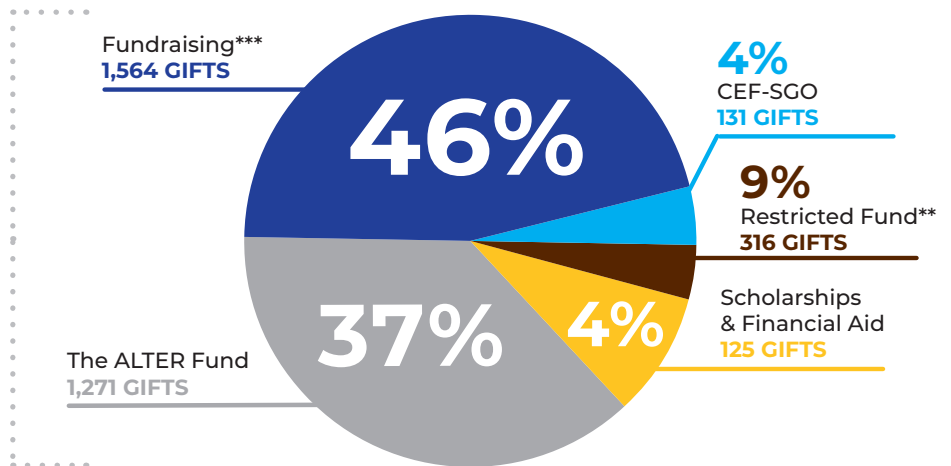
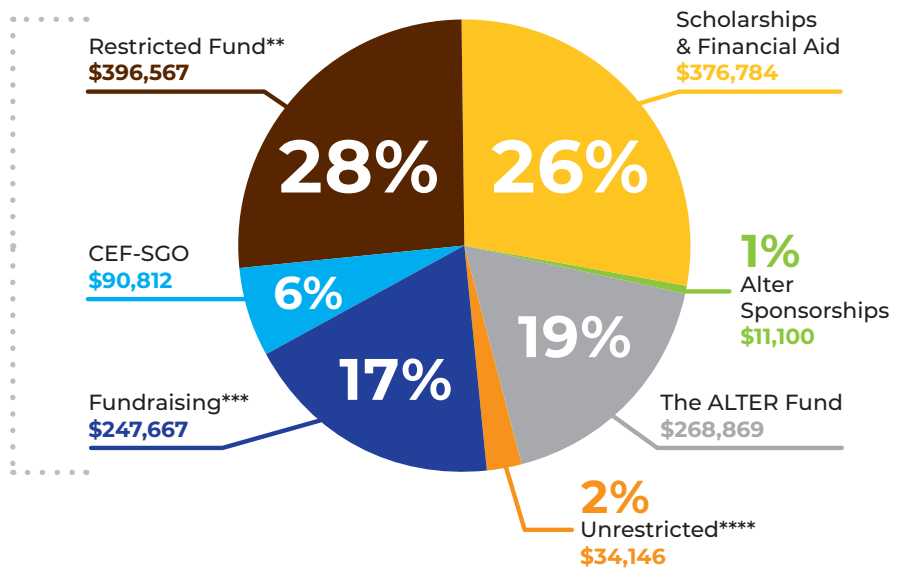
